OSA Up-skilling Program 2023

The OSA sponsored skill development program was conducted between January 2023 - March 2023. The objective of this program is to upskill and empower students with weak academic and economic background. The program covered 4 main skills, Tally, Ms-Office, GST and soft skills required to be corporate ready. Students from the above-mentioned background were handpicked by the class mentors and totally 60 students were trained under this program.







- Tally: 23rd Jan 2023 22nd Feb 2023
 Tally training program was provided by Alpha Tech Academy. The resource person for the session was Mr. Thulasi Naik. The program covered maintaining chart of accounts, creation of price list, bill-wise entry, purchase and sales order management, etc.,
- Ms-Office 20th March 2023 29th March 2023 Training on Ms-Office was also provided by Alpha Tech Academy. The resource person was Mr. Shreyas. The program covered basic excel, word and PowerPoint preparation and presentation.
- GST: 25th March 2023 &1st April 2023
 The GST training program was provided by Hiregange Academy. It was a full day session on both the days. Mr.Akshay Hiregange and two of his associates conducted three classroom sessions and one lab session familiarizing our students with GST related portals and processes.
- Soft Skill: 20th March 2023
 It was a one-day session which covered basic Resume building, corporate grooming, preparation for personal interview, etc.,
 The program was well received by the students and the feedback about each session was positive.






